Dear Parent/Guardian,

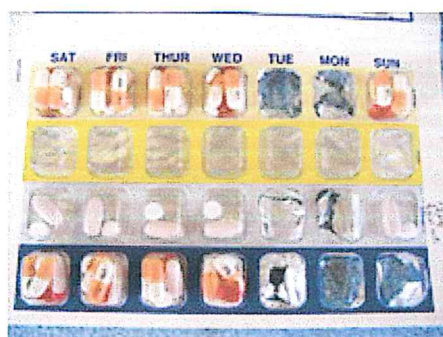
I am requiring that if your camper needs to receive medication for the week, you bring it to camp pre-packaged by your local pharmacy. Here are some guidelines for you.

- All medications (including over the counter meds, PRN (as needed), vitamins/supplements, advil/aspirin etc.) should be prepackaged for a one week stay at camp by your pharmacy of choice.
- Do not bring them in the prescription pill bottle or prepare it in any way by yourself.
- Do not bring more than a one week supply of medications.
- Please consider leaving at home any non-essential vitamins, creams etc. as this only delays the staff in meeting the needs of other campers with more serious issues.

If your local pharmacy does not prepackage medication or if you have any questions do not hesitate to contact me, as you may be turned away on check in day if your medications are not properly packaged to the satisfaction of our nursing staff.
