As a Counselor-in-Training (CIT) at Camp Fatima/Camp Bernadette, you are expected to behave in a manner that is in accord with the philosophy of our Diocesan Camps and to be respectful to other campers, CIT's, and staff. CIT's need to abide by all rules set by the Executive Director, Resident Director, CIT Director, and any head staff member of authority. Acceptance to the CIT program is a privilege and not a right. The CIT program is designed to help shape future counselors; it is not an extension of your Club/Suite 15 summer. You are expected to put in a good faith effort during your time at Camp Fatima/Bernadette. Please note that if you are not meeting the expectations of the CIT program or are in violation of any rules, your parents may be notified, and you may be dismissed from the CIT program.

I understand and agree that all transportation expenses shall be the responsibility of the undersigned parent or guardian. If you are suspected of being in possession of any weapons, illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco, inappropriate/explicit material, or stolen property, Camp Fatima/Bernadette reserves the right to search your personal belongings in its pursuit to safeguard the safety and property of the campers and staff.
